GENERAL FUND and STUDENT CREDIT

The General Fund gives the MPS Music Association the opportunity to provide financial support to the Music Department and scholarships to graduating seniors.

Student Accounts help students build credit into their account to offset the cost of out-of-state music festivals (competitions) and other music related expenses. The credit accumulates throughout the year and carries over from year to year. **This is Important To YOU Because It Saves YOU Money!**

General Fund

These fund raisers are provided by adults. 100% of the profit goes into the general fund:

Concession Stand — Set Up and Sell food items at home football games.

Concert Concessions — Set-Up and Sell food items and other duties at MPS music concerts (grades 4—12). And other activities as requested.

Gift Wrap — Solomon Pond Mall provides MPS Music Association a kiosk at the mall to offer gift wrapping services to the mall patrons during the winter holiday season. MPS Music Association receives 100% of the proceeds.

Coat Check — Paradise City Arts Festival comes to Marlborough twice a year (November and March). MPS Music Association runs their coat check service. MPS Music Association receives 100% of the proceeds. Our volunteers who work the coat check do not pay the entrance fee and are encouraged to stroll through the Festival before or after their shift.

Student Accounts

Students can raise funds to pay for their entire out-of-state music festival trip. It takes some effort and it's important to fund raise every year to accumulate funds. Working to raise funds over two years is easier than trying to raise funds in only one school year.

Monthly Fund Raisers

Various fund raisers are provided for students to sell items on an individual basis. Students receive a certain percentage of items sold.

Example:

Holiday Gift Catalog	40% of sales
MHS Concert Tickets	Ticket cost less \$1.00
Pops Concert Ad Book	50% of ads sold

On-Going Fund Raiser

Hebert Candy Bars are available to sell on an individual basis at your work location or to family and friends at a price of \$1.00 each. 50% of the candy sales get credited to the Student's Account.

Two ways to obtain the candy bars:

Purchase Up Front for \$40.00 Student receives 40 candy bars and a \$20 credit to his/her account.

Purchase on Account Get one box of 40 candy bars. A negative \$20.00 gets applied to Student Account. Sell the candy & turn in the \$40.00 The Student Account is reversed to a positive \$20.00
